

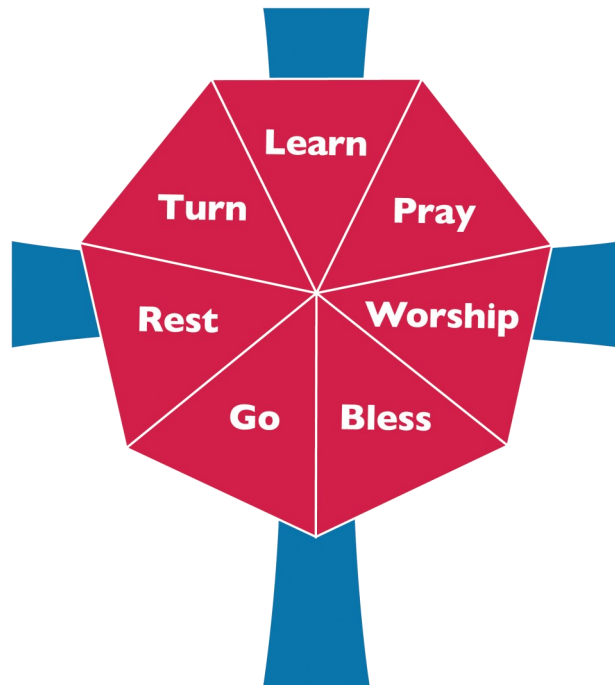
# Lenten Opportunities at Immanuel

10:15 A.M., PARISH HALL**

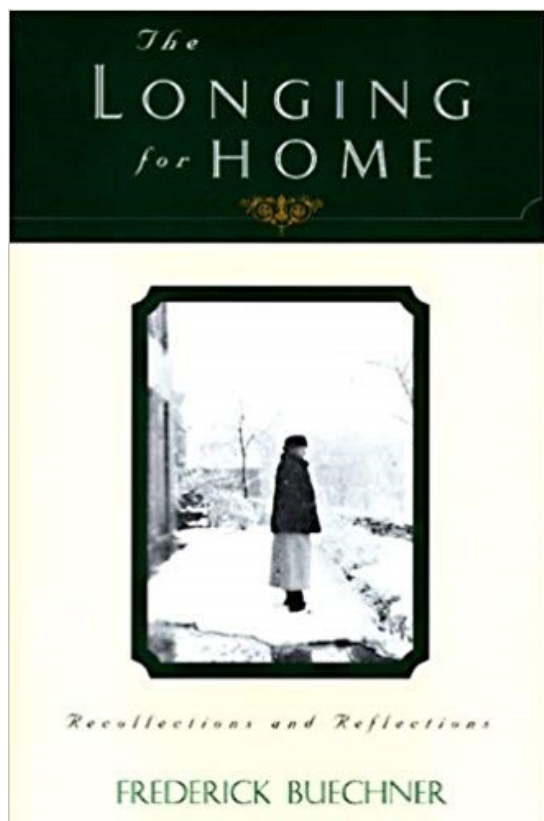
